

Student Displays

Each school is requested to present a minimum of one student display at the High School Leadership Conference dinner on Friday, August 14, 2009. Students will have the opportunity to showcase their organization's most successful, creative, unique, fun, meaningful, etc. projects to other students from schools across Utah. Students will also vote to decide which displays will win an award.

Display requirements: Individuals and groups applying for the conference must indicate on the application if they will be bringing a display. Each group is allowed one display. If different group representatives from the same school attend, each group can bring one display (senior class officers are allowed one display, National Honors Society is allowed one display, Community of Caring allowed one display, etc...) Each group will be allocated one table space for the display. You can bring anything from a Power Point presentation showcasing different events for Homecoming to a poster explaining the fundraiser to save the lunch lady to a video highlighting the school's musicals or plays. Creativity is encouraged! Please bring your own materials and technology.
