

Cleveland-Lloyd Dinosaur Quarry

Utah is home to one of the most famous dinosaur quarries in the world, the Cleveland-Lloyd Dinosaur Quarry. Located in Emery County near the small town of Cleveland, it has yielded over 12,000 bones from at least nine different Late Jurassic dinosaurs since excavations began in 1927.

Among the 150 million-year-old dinosaurs recovered there are:

Allosaurus, Camarasaurus, and Stegosaurus

The University of Utah has a long history of excavation at the site, and the Utah Museum of Natural History houses the great majority of this internationally renowned collection. These fossils are an outstanding resource for continuing research and education.
