A reserved camping area at the BLM's, Gold Bar Campground on highway 279, space is limited so get your reservations in soon. This campground is primitive with no hookups and is located directly on the banks of the Colorado River just past Poison Spider Mesa, just minutes away from many of your favorite trails and downtown Moab. Camp areas are available Friday afternoon, Sept 2nd through Monday afternoon, Sept 5th. Camping is not required. See inside for more details.

- Breakfast will be provided on Saturday morning at the campground for campers & non-campers.
- Dinner will be provided on Sunday evening at the campground for campers & non-campers.
- Water –BLM concrete Restrooms (no running water) – No hookups.

DIRECTIONS TO CAMPGROUND:

- Coming from the south? - From Moab, travel 5 miles north on U.S. Highway 191. Turn left (west) on Utah Highway 279 and drive 10 miles. Turn left into the Gold Bar Recreation Site.
- Coming from the north? - Traveling south on U.S. Highway 191, turn right onto Utah Highway 279 just past the entrance to Arches National Park, drive 10 miles. Turn left into the Gold Bar Recreation Site.

CAMPGROUND AMENITIES INCLUDE:

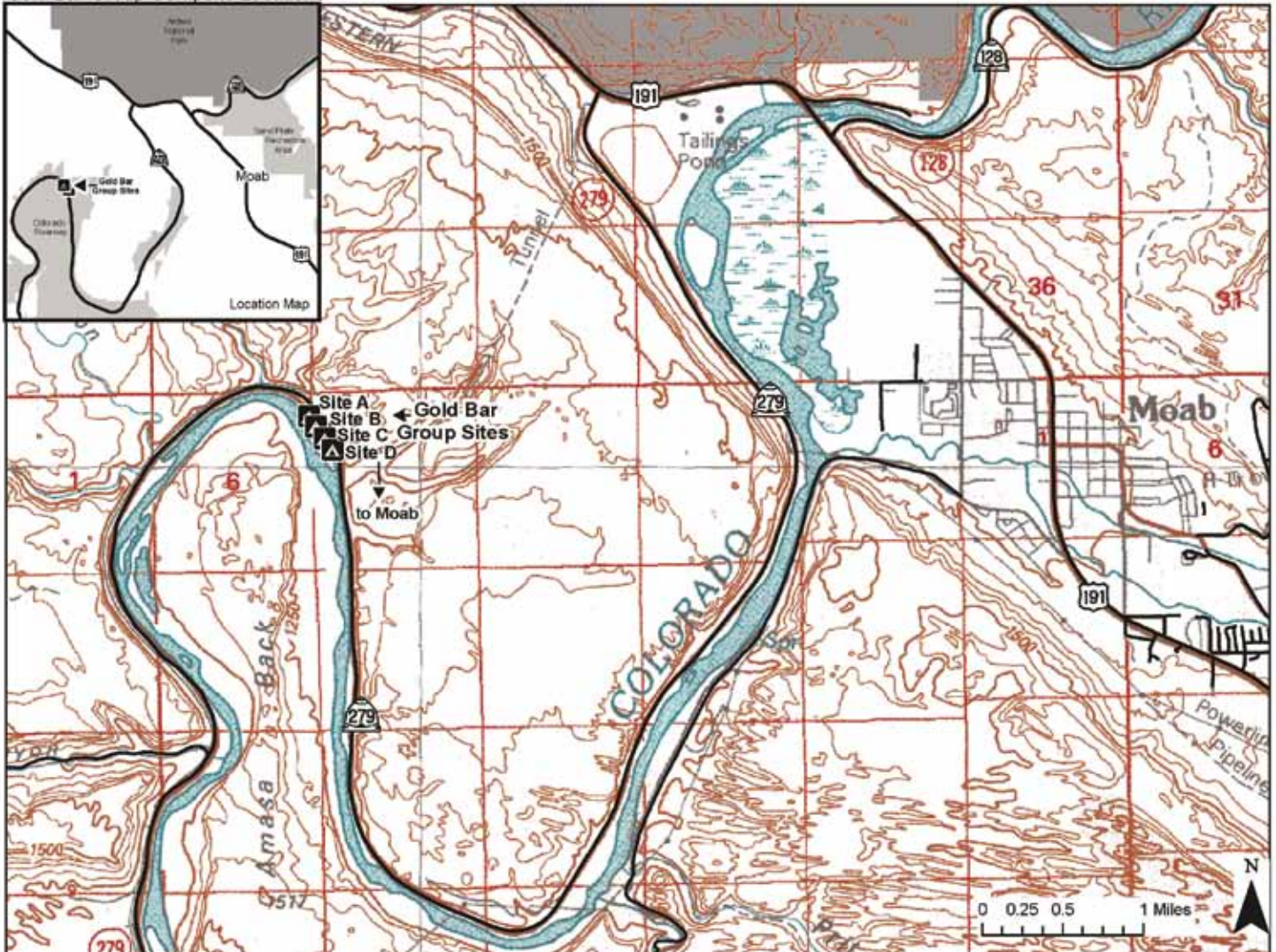
This is a primitive campground but does have some amenities as follows:

- Toilets – concrete outdoor toilets are adjacent to each group camping area
- Fire rings and picnic tables are available at each campsite
- Water will be brought in for use but no running water is available
- Sites A, B, and C each have a shade shelter and a stand-up grill
- walk-in tent camping with vehicle parking immediately outside the site
- Site D allows RVs to drive up to the actual site
- Ample parking is available for even the largest recreational vehicles
- BREAKFAST – SATURDAY MORNING 7:00 – 8:00 AM:
- Pancakes & Bacon – bring your chairs
- DINNER – SUNDAY NIGHT 6:00
- Burgers & Sides – bring your chairs
