

## **Teacher and Student Guidelines for your Museum Visit**



### **Museum of Moab's Experiential Education Centers (EEC)**

**1. Call the Museum one week before your visit, to check what days are available. Ask for Andrea Stoughton to make an appointment or Travis Schenck the Curator of the Museum. Andrea Stoughton is the Program Coordinator. **2. Please give Andrea the following information when you make an appointment:**

**Teacher's name and grade. Date and time you will arrive.**

**How many students in your classroom. How many parents will attend?**

**Do you have special needs children? Behavior disorders?**

**How long do you plan to stay? How many centers do you plan to attend?**

**Do you plan to have sack lunch at the Museum?**

**3. Teacher preparation before the trip to the Museum:**

**Nametags for the kids. Divide the kids into two groups.**

**Please ask the kids to ask before they touch something in an exhibit. We have "Hand" signs up that allow you to be interactive with the exhibit.**

**Explain to your class that the items in the Museum are irreplaceable.**

**4. Student Behavior Expectations:**

**Respect the Museum, teachers, instructors, parents and especially other kids.**

**Do not leave the group without permission to wander around the Museum.**

**Bathroom breaks and drinks will be available before and after the centers are over. Do not ask unless it is urgent!**

**Transition from center to center should take one minute. When the class hears the bell clanking they must stop what they're doing and move to the next center.**
