For Students Entering Grades 4-8

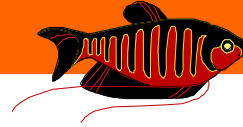
At the children's choir session students will explore music from composers with ties to Utah, including a premier of a composition of University of Utah's Miguel Chuaqui. In addition to a concert in Libby Gardner Hall participants will have the wonderful experience of performing selections of the repertoire at Mass at the Cathedral of the Madeleine on Sunday, July 19.

After morning rehearsals, students registered for the all-day program may choose to take group voice lessons, learn to play handbells, explore music theory, take conducting lessons, work on keyboard improvisations, or explore rhythm through dance. Highlights will include a field trip to the Cathedral of the Madeleine organ loft at which keyboard improvisation students will have a chance to try out their arrangements, and a performance of all elective classes for family and friends.

The best way to explore music is through play! Students will have fun getting to know composers through song, dance and violin playing, They will learn about music theory through rhythm games – watch out, here come the boomwhackers. Students will be able to enjoy beginning and intermediate group violin lessons and they will explore ways to express music through movement. But most of all, everyone will sing, and sing, and sing ... rounds, hymns, spirituals, folk songs ... there will be something for everyone!

Faculty

Melanie Malinka, a native of Stuttgart, Germany, has served as Director of Music at The Madeleine Choir School since 2001. In this position she oversees the school's rigorous choral program of four choirs for children ages 9 – 14. She leads the preparation of the choristers for their extensive concert season, regular service commitments, international tours, and engagements with leading local arts organizations including Utah Symphony and Opera and the Mormon Tabernacle Choir. She regularly conducts the Cathedral Choir on the Cathedral of the Madeleine concert series and has appeared many times as a soloist on the same series. Melanie has led numerous guest clinics with the Utah Symphony Chorus, whose singers she prepared for concert engagements during the summer 2008. She also maintains a private voice studio focusing on boy sopranos, counter tenors, and young adolescent voices. Melanie holds a Bachelor of Music degree in voice performance from Westminster Choir College of Rider University. She currently is pursuing a Masters of Music in Choral Conducting at the University of Utah under the guidance of Dr. Brady Allred.

Ginger J. Christensen began her private study of the violin at age 5 in the Suzuki Method. After completing the Suzuki repertoire, she began traditional study with Nancy Parker with a total of 13 years of private study. She has played in many community orchestras in the Salt Lake valley including the Young Artist Chamber Players under the direction of Jack Ashton, and the Utah Youth Symphony with Barbara Scowcroft, conductor. She also played in the Northwest LDS Symphony in Vancouver, WA where she was the principal second violinist. Ginger graduated from Salt Lake Community College with an Associate of General Science degree. She also attended Brigham Young University where she took courses in vocal performance, dance, and theatre. She currently leads the violin program at The Madeleine Choir School and serves as the staff violin teacher at Riverton Music.

Born in northwestern Pennsylvania, **Jason McAdams**, tenor, was trained as an opera singer and currently serves as cantor for the Cathedral of the Madeleine. He received his Bachelor of Music from the Indiana University of Pennsylvania, and his Master of Music in vocal performance and pedagogy from the New England Conservatory of Music. In addition to his responsibilities as cantor of the cathedral, Jason also teaches music theory and vocal instruction at The Madeleine Choir School.

Music teacher and choral teacher **Julie Maughan** has been teaching at The Madeleine Choir School since 1996. She has been teaching voice and piano at her home studio for over 21 years. She has also played piano professionally in musical theater, including The Grand Theater and the Utah Shakespearean Festival for many years. Her association with the Cathedral began in 1995 as a choir member and cantor. Her duties at The Madeleine Choir School currently include teaching music to grades Prekindergarten through 2, leading the preparation of the St. Nicholas choristers, and teaching piano as part of the Choir School's after-school instrumental program. Julie's great passion lies in helping children learn to explore and develop in music.

Kerrin Gates graduated from the University of Utah in 2007 with a Bachelor of Music Degree in Music Education. She is an avid participant in the art of choral singing and has sung in choirs throughout her secondary and higher education, including 3 years as a member of the internationally acclaimed University of Utah Singers. She is currently a member of the Salt Lake Choral Artists. She taught for one year at the Madeleine Choir School following her graduation, working mainly with the St. Nicholas choir, but also providing vocal coaching and music tutoring. She currently teaches choir at Bingham High School, where she is privileged to teach 6 choirs from beginning to advanced levels.

Faculty

Douglas O'Neill is an active performer on organ, piano, and harpsichord. He holds degrees from the University of Evansville, the University of Iowa, and the University of Kansas, where he completed a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Church Music. He has performed solo and collaborative concerts throughout the United States and Europe, and he has been selected to compete in several prestigious competitions. He is currently Organist and Assistant Director of Music at the Cathedral of the Madeleine, where he plays for liturgies and concerts, and works with students from The Madeleine Choir School.
