The virtual incubator will be located at SLCC's Miller campus at 9750 South 300 West in Sandy, Utah.

Clients of the virtual incubator benefit from invaluable business services such as mail forwarding, receptionist service, a business communication package, online Microsoft Office access, and data storage backup services.

Onsite business services are also provided and include: a working address for those who prefer a Salt Lake City address; on-site wireless, access to office cubicles, support centers and conference facilities; free attendance to monthly BizNetConnect events. Small business owners are also entitled to discounted professional services and business training workshops.


Virtual incubator clients also have close proximity to Salt Lake Community College's Miller Campus Business Innovation Center—which offers a wide array of business resources and support organizations. These include the Salt Lake Small Business Development Center, the US Department of Commerce Export Assistance Center, the Procurement Technical Assistance Center Regional Office, the Women's Business Institute, a Corporate Training Solutions center and a Global Management training center.
